- Make expectations clear and specific for children and co teachers. Follow through with consequences that are consistent with Positive Discipline while always modeling acceptable behavior;
- Exhibit professionalism in attendance, dress, demeanor and policies.

- A consistent, positive attitude with genuine interest in children's academic, social and emotional growth
- An ability to be inherently organized with a desire to go the extra-mile to support the child and school culture.
